START YOUR DAY IN **Disneyland** (ARRIVE AT PARK OPEN)

Prioritize *Haunted Mansion*® Holiday first.

Focus on doing *Haunted Mansion*® Holiday early before the standby line gets too long. If you're getting Lightning Lane Multi Pass, choose it as your first option.

Take photos in front of the giant pumpkin on *Main Street, U.S.A.*® Area.

Grab the group shot before the tadpoles get tired, the weather plays a factor or shadows creep in.

Keep an eye out for characters.

Characters in costumes, both heroes and villains, may be greeting guests in Town Square and the *Fantasyland*® Area. Popular rare characters, such as Jack Skellington and Sally in New Orleans Square, may have long lines, so it's best to meet them early.

Celebrate Día de Los Muertos.

El Zócalo Park in *Frontierland*® Area hosts a special tribute to Día de Los Muertos with authentic skeleton figurines called calacas.

Grab spooky grub.

We love the special foods and drinks offered during Halloween Time. Once the bellies start growling, seek out the Bulgogi Toasted Sandwich at Jolly Holiday Bakery Cafe or the Haunted Hound Dog at Galactic Grill.

(CAN HOP AS EARLY AS 11 A.M.)

Take the tadpoles to Mickey's Trick and Treat.

Catch a special Halloween show in Hollywood Land in the late morning or afternoon. Join Mickey Mouse, Minnie Mouse, Donald Duck, Goofy and a mad scientist for a few spooky surprises.

Meet puppet Miguel.

Don't miss Plaza de la Familia in *Paradise Gardens Park*, where you can watch "A Musical Celebration of Coco" and meet puppet Miguel. The show usually takes place hourly in the afternoon, with the last showing around 5 p.m. There are also fun arts and crafts, including coloring your own alebrije masks.

Ride Guardians of the Galaxy - Monsters After Dark.

After 3 p.m., the popular ride reopens as its spooky version. If you're visiting on an Oogie Boogie Bash party night but aren't attending, be sure to hop in line between 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. We recommend that small kids sensitive to loud noises, drops and the dark skip this ride

Visit *Cars Land*® Area at night.

Not only is *Cars Land*® Area lit up at night, but you can also enjoy ride overlays, Luigi's Honkin' Haul-O-Ween and Mater's Graveyard JamBOOree. (Visit on a non-Oogie Boogie Bash party night.)

Eat dinner and dessert.

Make a pit stop for a Slow Burnin' Mac & Cheese Cone or the Mater Haul-O-Ween Cone at Cozy Cone. On the way out, stop by Aunt Cass Cafe for Chicken Pot Pie Soup and Caramel Apple Bread Pudding.

The fireworks show takes place on weekends only (weather permitting) during Halloween Time, so be sure to plan your visits accordingly if you don't want to miss the fireworks at 9:30 p.m. The show still runs with projections during the week.
