

MICKEY'S NOT-SO-SCARY HALLOWEEN PARTY



Time flies scary fast when you're having fun! Our *Mickey's Not-So-Scary Halloween Party* Park Plan will help you hit the highlights with the lowest wait times.

ARRIVAL (4 P.M.)

Arrive early.

With a party ticket, guests can enter *Magic Kingdom*® Park as early as 4 p.m. Allow extra time for parking, security, transportation by bus, boat or monorail and entering the park.

Grab your wristband.

If you're already in the park before 4 p.m. as a daytime guest, go to a wristband distribution location between 4-7 p.m. so you can stay inside the park. If you arrive after 4 p.m., you'll get your wristband upon arrival through the designated touchpoints.

PRE-PARTY TIME (4 P.M. TO 7 P.M.)

Hit the rides.

Are you focusing on special entertainment, characters and trick-or-treating during the party? Go on rides now. Not all rides and shows are open during the event, so make sure to prioritize any must-dos. Save any rides with special overlays for the party.

Eat dinner.

Take the extra time now to sit down and fuel up before the party starts. Because time is limited, we recommend a quick-service spot such as Casey's Corner or load up on snacks such as the Pumpkin Sundae from Plaza Ice Cream Parlor.

Visit non-party characters.

Meet characters who don't appear during the party, and save meeting characters in their Halloween costumes for the party. Some party-exclusive characters, such as Jack Skellington and Sally, start queuing for guests with party wristbands as early as 4 p.m., but lines can get long very quickly.

PARTY TIME (7 P.M. TO 12 A.M.)

Get exclusive treats and party merch early.

Some special treats and party-exclusive merchandise may draw long lines and sell out early in the night.

Prioritize characters.

If you must visit a certain character, be sure to do so earlier in the night, as some may leave their location to be in the parade or cut off the line 30 minutes before the party ends. Double check with a cast member to find out how long a line is. New this year at Town Square Theater, Jack will debut a new look, and Mickey and Minnie will greet guests together for the first time. Visit Jack Skellington and Sally during the first parade (8:15 p.m.).

Due to their popularity, Jack Skellington and Sally start greeting guests with party wristbands at 4 p.m. but unless you're one of the first people in line, skip them and wait until the first parade when their wait time tends to dip.

Find a spot for fireworks (10 p.m.).

Arrive around 9:30 p.m. (just after the 9:05 p.m. showing of Hocus Pocus Villain Spelltacular) to find a spot in the hub for a good view of the projections on Cinderella Castle and the Pumpkin King himself.

Trick or treat later.

There can be long lines for the treat trails early on, so later in the night is the best time to trick or treat with little to no waits.

PARTY TIME (PT. 2)

Watch the second parade (11:15 p.m.) in *Frontierland*®.

Grab a spot in *Frontierland*® for a good view with shorter notice. While you wait, the Headless Horseman gallops along the entire parade route about 15-20 minutes before the rest of the parade. It's also where the parade begins — as soon as it passes by, you can *hop* to *Tiana's Bayou Adventure* or other rides in the area.

Circle back to characters and sprinkle in your favorite rides.

With the remaining time left, catch any characters you may have missed, including the dance parties and villain sightings, and go on your favorite rides — both of which have lower wait times as the night goes on.

Finish the night with the Sanderson sisters (12 a.m.).

By watching the last stage show of the night, you get to stay past the official party time to close out the park with the Sanderson sisters and their villainous friends.

**Entertainment may be shortened, postponed or canceled due to weather, so keep weather forecasts in mind on the day of your party and stay flexible.*
