MEET THE FLEET

The *Disney Cruise Line* fleet is comprised of six *frogtaacular* ships — *Disney Magic*, *Disney Wonder*, *Disney Dream*, *Disney Fantasy*, *Disney Wish* and *Disney Treasure*. The *Disney Destiny* and *Disney Adventure* are set to join the fleet in late 2025.

The **Magic Class** ships are the smallest, at 84,000 tons, carrying about 2,700 passengers. They offer a cozy feel and sail unique routes, such as Alaska and the South Pacific.

The *Disney Adventure* is *Disney Cruise Line's* first ship based in Singapore and the only ship in the **Global Class**. It will accommodate around 6,700 guests and 2,500 crew members. This massive 208,000-gross-ton ship will offer 3- and 4-night cruises filled with Disney, Pixar and Marvel experiences. Currently under construction in Germany, it is set to debut Dec. 15, 2025.

HOW TO CHOOSE YOUR CRUISE

When choosing your Disney cruise, it's all about finding the right balance between your interests, desired destination, budget and timing. With each ship as its own destination, there are no bad choices!

Deposit: You can pay for your cruise in full or secure your reservation with a 10% deposit. After that, you have the flexibility to make payments at your convenience and in any amount, as long as the full balance is paid by the final payment deadline.

Final Cruise Payment: Due dates (if not paid in full)

- 3-5 day cruises - 90 days prior
- 6+ day cruises - 120 days prior
- Concierge Level - 90 days for 1-5 day cruises, 120 days prior for 6+ day cruises

Refund Policy: Refunds on cruise deposits and any payments made vary by room type and itinerary. Review the terms for your specific sailing for more details.

Length: Short cruises (3-5 days) versus extended voyages (7+ days)

Disney Cruise Extras: Plan for those additional costs not included in your sailing, including gratuities and souvenirs.

Itinerary: Choose from tropical getaways, cultural stops or adventurous destinations. Review ports of call and exclusive island visits.

Time of Year: Peak holiday seasons versus off-season

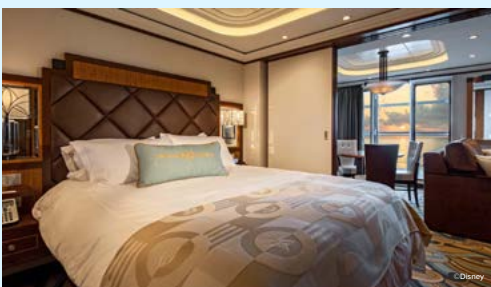

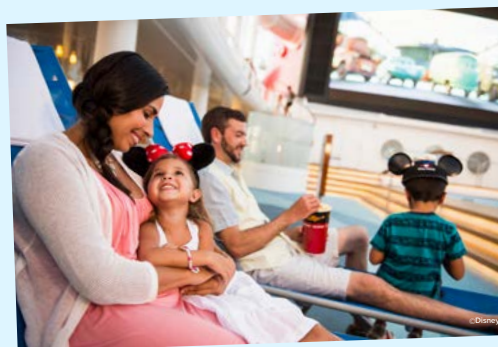

Babies and Toddlers (6 months - 3 years old)

- ✦ The *it's a small world* nursery provides childcare with advance reservations at an additional hourly cost.
- ✦ *Disney Cruise Line* offers complimentary diaper disposals, bottle warmers, sterilizers, cribs and playpens.
- ✦ High chairs and fresh pureed vegetables are available upon request.
- ✦ Complimentary strollers and beach wagons are available at Guest Services and Disney *Castaway Cay* and Disney *Lookout Cay*.
- ✦ Baby care essentials are sold at onboard merchandise shops.
- ✦ Babies must be at least 6 months to sail most itineraries and 12 months for Transatlantic, Hawaii and Panama Canal cruises.
- ✦ Swim diapers are not permitted in swimming pools, but water playgrounds are available on each ship.
- ✦ Pre-packed, unopened baby food and formula can be brought onboard as carry-on items.

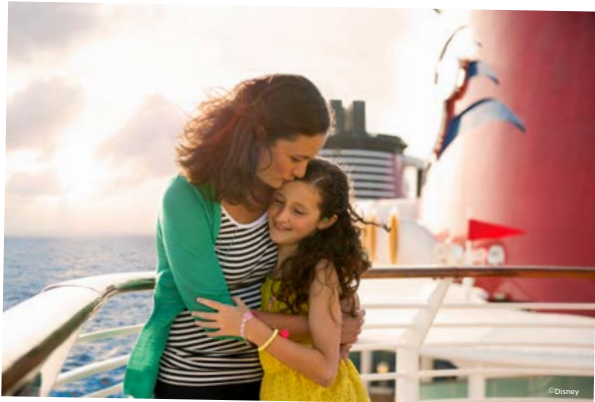

There's a lot to think about when packing for a Disney cruise, and what you'll need on your vacation will vary depending on your destination. Use our checklist to take the guesswork out of packing and keep things organized from start to finish.

Travel Documents

- Passports or other accepted proof of citizenship for all travelers (including children)
- Valid photo identification for adults (such as a driver's license or government-issued photo ID)
- Disney Cruise Line* reservation confirmation and Online Check-In Port Arrival Form
- Any required citizenship documentation
- Signed documentation for minors traveling without a parent
- Pre- and post-cruise travel information such as flights, hotel or rental car details
- Proof of travel insurance (if applicable)



A copy of your wedding certificate may be needed if your passport is in your maiden name.

Embarkation Day Carry-On

Two weeks prior to your cruise, you'll receive luggage tags with further instructions in the mail. Remember, whether your luggage is grabbed by a porter at a *Walt Disney World*® Resort hotel, at the airport on the day of your sailing or at your arrival at the port, you'll be separated from your luggage for a little while! Be sure to pack anything you anticipate needing in the first few hours of your trip in your carry-on, including:

- Cell phones with charging cords and battery packs
- Medication (in their original containers)
- Credit cards and cash for onboard expenses and tips
- Glasses or contact lenses
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen and hat
- Swimsuit and cover-up
- Sandals/flip-flops
- Baby care essentials (if applicable)
- Toothbrush, toothpaste and other toiletries to freshen up
- DisneyBand+* or *MagicBand+* (if you have a *MagicBand+* that you purchased at *Walt Disney World*® Resort or *Disneyland*® Resort, you can use it as a *DisneyBand+* onboard)
- Autograph books and pens
- Camera
- Reusable water bottles
- Lanyards for holding your Key to the World cards

- Comfortable walking shoes for shore excursions
- Dress shoes for evening events
- Flip-flops or sandals for casual wear
- Sturdy footwear for Alaskan and Canadian cruises (boots or rubber-sole shoes)

Accessories

- Day bag or backpack for carrying essentials during shore excursions
- Travel-sized umbrella

- Travel adapters and converters (if traveling internationally)
- Binoculars (for wildlife or scenic views from verandahs or excursions)

- ✦ Each guest is permitted to bring up to two suitcases, one carry-on and one personal bag (such as a purse) per person aboard.
- ✦ Guests 21 years and older can bring up to 2 unopened bottles of wine or champagne or 6 beers on board at the start of the voyage and at each port of call. These drinks will need to be in your carry-on bags, not in your checked luggage.
- ✦ The stateroom doors are magnetic!
- ✦ The beds are at the perfect height to store your luggage underneath and out of the way!



EMBARKATION & DEBARKATION DAYS

Both embarkation and debarkation are exciting but busy days. Use our checklists to help make the process smooth and easy, from boarding the ship to leaving after your adventure!

Disney Cruise Line Embarkation Day Checklist

- Complete Online Check-In***
Upload photos and travel documents on the *Disney Cruise Line* website or the *Disney Cruise Line Navigator* app. Choose your Port Arrival Time. We recommend completing this at least 30 days before your cruise, but these forms must be completed at least 1 day prior to your sailing.
- Arrive the Day Before**
Book a hotel near the port to avoid delays.
- Attach Luggage Tags**
Put the *Disney Cruise Line* tags that were mailed to you on your luggage before arriving. These will arrive in the mail prior to sailing.
- Pack a Carry-On**
Include a swimsuit, sunscreen, snacks, baby care items, medications, flip flops and charging cords.
- Check-in at the Terminal**
Have your Port Arrival Form and travel documents ready.
- Connect to Wi-Fi***
Use the *Disney Cruise Line Navigator* app to access schedules and buy a data package if needed.
- Grab Lunch**
Head to the buffet, poolside eats or a dining room.
- Explore the Ship***
Visit the kids club during open house, Guest Services to book or make changes to dining or Port Adventure reservations or the spa for special offers and giveaways.
- Find Your Stateroom***
Unpack and settle in once your room is ready. Staterooms are typically ready around 1:30 p.m. Times will be posted on monitors at the port and on the ship. Your luggage will be delivered to your stateroom door (and placed just outside your door) but may not arrive until later in the afternoon. Your Key to the World card (stateroom key) will be posted in an envelope outside your stateroom door.
- Attend the Mandatory Assembly Drill***
Your assembly drill station can be found in the *Disney Cruise Line Navigator* app, on your Key to the World card and on the back of your stateroom door.
- Join the Sail Away Celebration**
Head to the top deck for music, characters and fun!
- Check Your Dinner Time & Table Number***
Don't miss your first Rotational Dining experience or the evening show.
- Shop Early**
Visit the shops after sailing for exclusive cruise merch.
- Complete the Pre-Trip Health Questionnaire.**
This form is available the morning you depart, either via the app or online.

EMBARKATION & DEBARKATION DAYS

Disney Cruise Line Debarkation Checklist

Night Before:

- Shop for Any Last-Minute Purchases**
Purchase photo packages or souvenirs.
- Settle Your Account**
Check your onboard charges in the *Disney Cruise Line Navigator* app or at Guest Services.
- Pack Your Luggage**
Set your tagged luggage outside your stateroom door by the designated time.
- Keep a Carry-On**
Include essentials such as clothing, toiletries, medications and travel documents.
- Prepare Travel Documents**
Keep your passport or government-issued ID/passport handy for customs and immigration.



Day Of:

- Eat Breakfast**
Head to your assigned restaurant or the buffet for your final meal on board.
- Leave the Stateroom**
Make sure your stateroom is cleared out by the required time.
- Retrieve Your Luggage**
Collect your bags at the terminal after disembarking.
- Clear Customs**
Present your travel documents and declare any purchases.

Got early morning travel plans? Use Express Walk-Off! Keep your luggage with you, skip putting it out the night before and be among the first off the ship.

TIPS AND TRICKS

Here are our top tips for making the very most of your time on your Disney cruise!

DisneyBand+: First-time cruiser? You can purchase a *DisneyBand+* in advance or onboard. If you have *MagicBand+* from the parks, bring it along! It works for unlocking your stateroom, making purchases and interacting with features around the ship.

Tippling: *Disney Cruise Line* includes automatic gratuities (\$16 per night, per stateroom guest; \$27.25 for Concierge Level, per night, per stateroom guest) for your dining team and stateroom host in your overall cruise bill. You can prepay them on the *Disney Cruise Line* website or the *Disney Cruise Line Navigator* app.

Castaway Club Membership: There are certain perks and benefits associated with each level, but most importantly, your level determines your booking window for purchasing a new cruise vacation, onboard extras, Port Adventures and when you can complete the online check-in process. Gold, Platinum and Pearl levels come with increasing benefits — including discounts, a free gift in your stateroom and, for Platinum and Pearl members, a free dinner at *Palo*.

Consider bringing a pop-up hamper. This will come in handy to have a place to store dirty clothes and keep them from piling up on the floor or mixing with your clean clothes.

Disney Gift Cards and Disney Chase Visa Rewards Points: If you want to utilize, take these cards to Guest Services periodically to have them applied to your account. *Disney Cruise Line* automatically charges your credit card when it hits a specific charge threshold, so having gift cards applied to your charges before that happens is key!

Bring an extra card to turn the lights on in your stateroom. On the Dream and Triton Class ships, there's a panel on the wall that requires you to insert a card to turn on the lights. Many guests use their Key to the World card, but any card will work. Even an expired gym membership card or retail rewards card will do. That way you can keep your Key to the World card on you and not leave your travel party in the dark if you need to run out.

Transportation: If you're driving, make a parking plan. *Disney Cruise Line* offers parking at the port. For those flying in, pre-book your transportation (*Disney* ground transportation*, rideshares such as Uber/Lyft or private transfers).

- If you're sailing from Port Canaveral, **consider staying at a Walt Disney World® Resort hotel the night prior to (or after!) your cruise**, as *Disney* offers ground transfers for an additional fee, each way. Even better, you can arrange for *Disney Cruise Line* to transfer your luggage from the resort to the port. Plus, you'll be assigned a Port Arrival Time and allowed to check-in upon your arrival at Port Canaveral.

Lock in your Disney hotel stay for a **REFUNDABLE \$200 DEPOSIT** then pay the remainder 30 days prior to check-in when booking through Undercover Tourist!



- Guests can also book ground transfers between Orlando International Airport (MCO) and Port Canaveral for the same rate. *Disney* also offers luggage transfer options for guests transferring to and from the airport.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Royal Gathering

Reserve your spot 30 days before your sail date to meet several Disney Princesses at once. Reservations are free and available through the *Disney Cruise Line Navigator* app.

Laundry Services

Self-service laundry is available on all ships, complete with washers, dryers and detergent for purchase. You can also opt for full-service laundry and dry-cleaning services for a fee.

Photo Packages

Photo packages are available at Shutters Photography Shop. You can save some green by purchasing photo packages before your cruise either on the *Disney Cruise Line* website or on the *Disney Cruise Line Navigator* app. These include digital downloads of all your onboard photos. Be sure to purchase your photos before the end of your cruise. Your photos will no longer be available once you're back on land.

Dining Time Assignment

Choose between early (5:45 p.m.) or later (8:15 p.m.) dining times when booking. If your seating preference is not available, you can request an alternate seating time by joining a waitlist. Requests are subject to availability and can be made through *My Reservations* on the *Disney Cruise Line* website. You can also inquire at Guest Services once onboard.
