Tips for visiting the Empire State Building

- The Empire State Building has free WiFi throughout, so you can share your experience as you explore.
- When it comes to dining, drinks, and snacks, there are several options. Take your pick from the STATE Grill and Bar, Tacombi, Starbucks, and Sushi-Teria.
- The Empire State Building is fully ADA compliant. There are handicapped restrooms on the 86th Floor Observatory along with ramps, lowered viewing walls, and binoculars. Motorized and non-motorized wheelchairs are permitted.

Getting in: on arrival, please present your reservation confirmation, then proceed inside for entry. Scan your pass at the turnstile after security. That's it, you're in! Enjoy the view.

Please note: passes cannot be used to book sunset time slots. We suggest booking an evening time slot to enjoy sweeping views of Manhattan's city lights at night!

You can also view and amend your time slot - just head to the 'my bookings' section. You will need to present a copy of your booking to security for entrance to the building.

FAQS about Edge NYC

Q. How can I get to Edge NYC?

A. Edge NYC is easily accessible via the 7 train to Hudson Yards, as well as various bus routes, and it's within walking distance from the High Line.

Q. Are there any age restrictions to visit Edge NYC?

A. There are no age restrictions, but children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times while at Edge NYC.

Q. Is Edge NYC wheelchair accessible?

A. Yes, Edge NYC is fully wheelchair accessible, with ramps and elevators available for guests with mobility impairments.

Q. Can I bring my camera or tripod to Edge NYC?

A. You are welcome to bring cameras to capture the views, but tripods are not allowed for safety reasons and to avoid obstructing others' enjoyment.

Q. Are there dining options available at Edge NYC?

A. Yes, you can enjoy a variety of food and beverage options at the on-site cafe, Peak, which offers both indoor and outdoor seating with stunning views.

Top of the Rock Observatory

Tips for visiting the Top of the Rock Observation Deck

- Top of the Rock is open from 9AM to 12AM daily so you can visit day or night, sun up or sundown.
- Top of the Rock and the Rockefeller Center Tours are fully wheelchair accessible. There are handicapped restrooms at Top of The Rock. Licensed service dogs are welcome.

- Food and drinks are not permitted but there are plenty of dining options available at Rockefeller Center. Take your pick from a number ofdining options in Rockefeller Center including Lodi, Del Frisco's Grille, Bill's Bar & Burger, Dough, Chip City, and FuKu.
- Be sure you leave time to shop in Rockefeller Center at iconic stores including FAO Schwarz, Nintendo, Kate Spade, NBC Store, LEGO, Mulberry, Cole Haan, and Michael Kors.
- Download the Top of the Rock App before your trip. It acts as a skyline guide and as an audio tour.

Top of the Rock Observation Deck FAQS

Q. What is Top of the Rock Observatory?

A. Top of the Rock Observatory is an iconic observation deck located on the top of the Rockefeller Center in New York City.

Q. What are the opening hours of Top of the Rock Observatory?

A. Top of the Rock Observatory is open daily from 8:00 am to midnight, with the last elevator going up at 11:00 pm.

Group tours: if you are traveling with a tour group, please send a tour group leader to exchange all passes for timed admission tickets between 10AM and 11AM on the day you plan

to visit the observatory. Tour groups that arrive after 11AM without timed admission tickets may be turned away.

Tips for visiting the 9/11 Memorial & Museum.

- Allow two hours to see all the exhibits in the museum.
- Food and drink are not allowed in the museum, but there is a café in the museum pavilion.
- The historical exhibit may not be suitable for children under the age of 10.
- A limited number of wheelchairs are available free of charge (first-come, first-served basis). For more information, visit the 9/11 Memorial website.

911 Museum and Memorial FAQs

Q: What is the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

A: The 9/11 Museum and Memorial is more than just a museum; it's an emotional journey through one of America's darkest days. The museum features exhibitions that showcase artifacts from the site, personal stories from survivors, and multimedia displays that bring the events of September 11 to life..

Q: What is included in the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

A: The exhibitions at the museum include a range of artifacts such as twisted steel beams from the Twin Towers, wreckage from airplanes used in the attacks, personal items recovered from Ground Zero, and much more. Visitors can also view powerful videos that provide insight into what happened on that fateful day.

Q: What is the admission fee for the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

A: General admission to the museum costs \$29 for adults, while seniors (65+) and students with valid ID pay \$23. Admission is free for children under six years old. Keep in mind that tickets are timed entry only, so be sure to plan ahead.

Q: How long does it take to visit the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

A: Visitors typically spend about two hours exploring both indoor exhibitions and outdoor memorials. However, some visitors may choose to spend more time exploring specific areas or exhibits.

Q: Can I bring bags into the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

A: To ensure visitor safety as well as respect for this sacred space, bags larger than a small purse or camera bag are not allowed inside. Visitors can check their bags at a designated area before entering.

Q: Is photography allowed in the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

A: Photography is allowed throughout most of the museum for personal use. However, flash photography, tripods, selfie sticks, or video recording are not permitted. Be respectful when taking photos in this solemn place.

Q: Can I bring children to the 9/11 Museum and Memorial?

A: Yes! Children are welcome at both sites. Parents should be aware that some exhibits may be emotionally intense or difficult for young children to understand. The museum offers resources such as family guides to help parents navigate these topics with their children.

Getting your ticket: on the plaza between the Memorial and Museum, enter the box office line to redeem your pass for an admission time slot. During busy periods like summer and the holidays, we recommend visiting as early in the day as possible.

Do you still have time before your admission? Why not do a few things nearby while you wait! We recommend shopping and restaurants around the Oculus, a walk through Battery Park, a stroll down Wall Street, or a ride on the free Staten Island Ferry to see the Statue of Liberty from the water.

Please note: your pass includes general admission. Guided tours are available for an additional fee payable directly to the 9/11 Memorial & Museum.

Downloadable audio guides are available for an additional fee.

One World Observatory FAQS

Q. What is the location of One World Observatory?

A. One World Observatory is situated on the top floors of One World Trade Center in New York City.

Q. Which floors of One World Trade Center house the Observatory?

A. The One World Observatory occupies the 100th, 101st, and 102nd floors of the building.

Q. How long does it typically take to visit the Observatory?

A. A visit to One World Observatory generally takes approximately 1-2 hours.

Q. Are there dining options available at the Observatory?

A. Yes, there are dining options on the 101st floor, including a sit-down restaurant and a casual café.

Q. Is the One World Observatory accessible for people with disabilities?

A. Yes, the Observatory is fully accessible, offering wheelchair access and accommodations for those with special needs.

Q. Can I bring a camera or a tripod to capture the views?

A. Cameras are allowed, but tripods and selfie sticks are prohibited for safety reasons.

Tips for visiting the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island

- A limited number of wheelchairs are available on both Liberty and Ellis Island for no fee, but on a first-come, first-served basis. You will need an ID to use as a deposit. Guide dogs are welcome.
- The buildings and grounds on Liberty Island are ADA compliant.
- You are allowed to bring your own food and drinks to both the islands but it must be sealed. Food and drinks are not allowed in the pedestal or crown of the Statue of Liberty.
- There are dining options on both islands, provided by Evelyn Hill Inc.

Getting in: present your pass at the 'Reserve Ticket' entrance at your chosen departure point (remember that your pass must be valid when scanned at the time of your visit). Proceed

through the security screening facility before boarding the ferry.

Please note: access to the pedestal and crown of the Statue of Liberty is not included with your pass. If you wish to add access to those parts of the statue, you will need book 'Crown Reserve' and/or 'Pedestal Reserve' tickets separately and make reservations as soon as possible as space is limited and tours often sell out months in advance.

Children under four years old are admitted for free.

American Museum of Natural History FAQs

Q. What exhibits can I see at the American Museum of Natural History?

A. The museum has a vast collection of exhibits, including the Hall of Biodiversity, Hall of Saurischian Dinosaurs, the Rose Center for Earth and Space, and the Richard Gilder Center for Science, Education and Innovation.

Q. Can I bring my own food to the museum?

A. Outside food and beverages are not permitted inside the museum, but there are multiple cafes and restaurants available for dining.

Q. Is there parking available at the American Museum of Natural History?

A. The museum does not have a parking lot, but there are several parking garages available in the surrounding area.

Q. Are there any special events or exhibitions happening at the American Museum of Natural History?

A. Yes, the museum regularly hosts special events and temporary exhibitions, such as the Butterfly Conservatory and the Holiday Train Show.

Q. Are there any accommodations available for visitors with disabilities?

A. Yes, the museum provides accessibility services, including wheelchair rentals, sign language interpreters, and audio-described tours.

Q. What is the Pay What You Wish policy for local residents?

A. If you are a resident of New York, New Jersey or Connecticut, the amount you pay for General Admission to the Museum is up to you and includes access to more than 40 permanent exhibition halls, the Rose Center for Earth and Space, and the Richard Gilder Center for Science, Education, and Innovation. Please note that General Admission does not include ticketed exhibitions, the butterfly vivarium, the giant-screen film, and Hayden Planetarium Space Show.

Getting in: you must present your valid pass for scanning to receive entrance at either of these two locations:

- 1. Rose Center Entrance (81st St between Central Park West and Columbus Ave) and proceed downstairs to the Will Call window (*Insider tip:* this location often has shorter lines)
- 2. Main Entrance (79th St at Central Park West) and proceed to the Vouchers Desk

Included extra: your pass entitles you to free general admission. If you would like to upgrade your admission ticket to include a temporary exhibit, IMAX or 3D film, OR a Hayden Planetarium Space Show, you may do so for an additional fee directly at the Museum.

Tips for visiting the American Museum of Natural History

- The Natural History Museum New York is fully accessible.
- Consult the map of the museum to plan which exhibitions to see.

- Plan to spend around 2 hours 30 minutes at the Museum of Natural History, but reserve an extra hour if you intend to see a special exhibition.
- The museum doesn't allow food and drink, except for water bottles.
- Leave large bags behind at the hotel or you will have to leave them at Coat Check for an additional \$2 charge per item.

Tips for visiting MoMA NYC

- The morning is the most crowded time to visit. We suggest visiting during an alternate time.
- MoMA is accessible and wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis and are free of charge.
- Our checkroom is currently closed. Scooters, skateboards, rolling bags, and all items over 11×17×5" [28×43×13 cm] are not permitted in the Museum. All bags will be inspected upon arrival. Please wear backpacks on the front of your chest or carry them to the side.
- Photography is permitted, but video is not.
- There are dining opportunities within the museum including The Modern restaurant, Café 2, and The Terrace Cafe.

- Connect to MoMA NYC's free WiFi and get access to the museum's digital map and audio guides. Charging stations are also provided throughout the Museum.
- Join artists, curators, and creative thinkers for conversations and workshops in the Crown Creativity Lab, MoMA's new participatory space on Floor 2; or visit the family-friendly Art Lab.

A. MoMA is located at 11 West 53rd Street, New York, NY 10019, between Fifth and Sixth Avenues.

Q. Are there guided tours available at MoMA?

A. Yes, MoMA offers a variety of guided tours for visitors to explore the museum's exhibitions and collections.

Q. Is MoMA wheelchair accessible?

A. MoMA is fully wheelchair accessible, and wheelchairs are available for visitors at no additional charge.

Q. Can I bring my camera to MoMA?

A. Photography is allowed for personal, non-commercial use, but flash, tripods, and selfie sticks are prohibited.

Q. Does MoMA have a coat check?

A. Yes, MoMA provides a complimentary coat check for visitors to store their belongings during their visit.

Q. Are there dining options within the museum?

A. MoMA offers several dining options, including a cafe, a fine dining restaurant, and a coffee bar.

Getting in: once you arrive at the Museum, proceed through a security inspection. Scan your pass at any kiosk on the left side of the lobby to receive a printed ticket. Show your printed tickets at the gallery entrance for admission.

Please note: children ages 16 and under receive free general admission.
