Extended Evening Hours (for Deluxe guests). Guests staying at Deluxe Resort hotels also have access to select parks on select nights after the parks close to the general public, including access to a third virtual queue window, if in use (valid admission required).

Meals and snacks can be redeemed at any time during your stay. Unused meals and snacks will roll over day to day and expire at midnight on day of checkout.

Select Dining Packages are also redeemable on the Dining Plan. Credits vary depending on the selected restaurant.

ADVANCE DINING RESERVATIONS



The Advance Dining Reservation System, ADR for short, is a fancy name for making dining reservations at Disney's table-service restaurants. There are hundreds of dining opportunities on property, ranging from dinner shows to character dining. If you're not booking that far in advance, don't stress — there are some good quick-service options and restaurants that often have last-minute availability!

CHEAT SHEET

All guests (even those staying off-site) can make Walt Disney World_® Resort dining reservations!

Advance Dining Reservations can be made in the *My Disney Experience* app **60 days in advance** of your trip.

Most reservations become available around 5:45 a.m. EST or by calling 407-WDW-DINE at 7 a.m. EST.

Walt Disney World_® Resort hotel guests can book ADRs 60 days in advance for the length of their stay (up to 10 days).

You can make a reservation online for parties up to 20; your whole party does not need to be connected in *My Disney Experience* to make a reservation.

Select restaurants require a deposit upfront to reserve your spot.

Valid park admission (and a theme park reservation, if applicable) is required for in-park dining locations.

TOP TIPS

You can cancel a reservation up to 2 hours before your reservation time without penalty at most restaurants. Cancellations within the 2 hour window may result in a no-show charge, per person.

Make sure you have the latest version of the *My Disney Experience* app.

Have your credit card information saved in the app. This saves you an extra step during the process.

You can search for reservations within a 10-day range. Then you can filter by time and location

Work backward for the best availability if you are staying on-site.

If at first you don't succeed, keep checking up until (and during) your trip.

Don't *froget* about the walk-up list, available same-day when you're near select restaurants!

A paid skip-the-line service is available at *Walt Disney World*_® Resort — and you can purchase and start reserving your rides before your trip! Enter Lightning Lane Passes.



THERE ARE 3 TYPES OF LIGHTNING LANE PASSES:

- Lightning Lane Premier Pass

 Allows one-time entry to each Lightning Lane experience in one park for one day, no reservations needed
- Lightning Lane Multi Pass

 Similar to the previous Disney Genie+ service, and includes digital downloads of select *Disney PhotoPass®* attraction photos and videos
- Lightning Lane Single Pass
 Similar to the previous individual Lightning Lane selections separate, a la carte options

You can purchase and select up to 1 Lightning Lane Premier Pass per day; up to 3 Lightning Lane Multi Pass options per day; and/or up to 2 Lightning Lane Single Pass options per day, starting at 7 a.m. ET in the *My Disney Experience* app on the first day of your booking window eligibility:

Guests of Walt Disney World Resort Hotels and Other Select Hotels:

Make selections up to **7** days in advance for the length of your entire trip (up to **14** days).

All Other Guests:

Make selections up to **3** days in advance of your visit.



A new paid skip-the-line service is available at *Walt Disney World*. Resort — and you can purchase and start reserving your rides before your trip! Enter Lightning Lane Passes.



Exact pricing depends on the
Theme Park and date (Lightning
Lane Multi Pass and Lightning
Lane Premier Pass) or attraction
and date (Lightning Lane
Single Pass).

To view pricing, proceed to any Purchase button found on the home page, Tip Board or the Lightning Lane Passes section of the main menu in the My Disney Experience app.

Once you **select a date**, you'll see the pricing for both Multi Pass and Single Pass by Theme Park.

You can purchase Lightning Lane Multi Pass and Single Pass in the same transaction for each day.

Lightning Lane Premier Pass pricing and transactions are **separate.**

For advance Lightning Lane Multi Pass selections, attractions and experiences are split into **two tiers** at *Magic Kingdom®* Park, EPCOT® and Disney's Hollywood Studios®.

Be sure to prioritize your advance selections accordingly, as you can choose 1 from Tier 1 and choose 2 (or all 3) from Tier 2.

Multi Pass and Single Pass arrival windows are automatically selected, but you can modify any time window*. Once you make your selections, you have **five minutes** to confirm the times.

Once you're in the park and redeem your first Lightning Lane Multi Pass selection, you can make another from either Tier 1 or 2* in the same park — or a different park if you have park hopping capabilities. Just remember, "use one, get one"! *subject to availability

Know Before You Go

Pick your priorities. You can save your favorites using the "My Day" feature.

Start early. Aim for an early arrival window for at least one advance Multi Pass selection to maximize the service. If all times are later in the day, you won't be able to make a new one until you use one, unless you can modify to an earlier time.

Know how to modify. If you want to modify the theme park or date, you can switch it up until the moment you redeem your first Lightning Lane selection. If you want to modify the attraction or arrival time, you can change it up until the start of the arrival window. Act quickly if you see an earlier time pop up!

TIPS AND TRICKS



Here are our top tips and tricks for making the very most of your time at *Walt Disney World* ® Resort!



Decide in advance where you want

to go. Use our list of attractions so you can decide what your priorities are for each park. Make planning your trip a family affair, and let everyone pick a couple of rides that are must-dos.

Pick the best day to visit. Use our Crowd Calendar to identify the best dates to visit the Walt Disney World® Resort and then the best parks to visit on each day of your trip. Since Magic Kingdom® Park is always the busiest park, try to visit on a green day.

Download our Orlando Theme Park
Day app. It offers key showtimes, crowd
levels, wait times and the optimal time to visit
each attraction.

Utilize on-site perks. If you're staying at a Walt Disney World® Resort hotel, you can enter any of the theme parks 30 minutes early on each day of your stay (valid admission required). Likewise, hotel guests are able to purchase Lightning Lane Passes up to seven days in advance for their entire length of stay. All other guests can purchase up to three days in advance.

Arrive before the parks open. The first few hours are the least busy times in the park, and you can experience a lot more when crowds are low.

Consider Disney Lightning Lane

Passes. These paid services enable guests to wait in an expedited line for popular attractions. The price varies by date and must be purchased through the *My Disney Experience* app for each member of your party. Remember, this service is *toadally* optional and all attractions still have a free means of entry — either by standby or virtual queue (if in use).

Experience the most popular rides with the lowest durations first.

You can follow one of our park plans or customize your own. If you aren't a family of early risers or you want more flexibility than a park plan offers, use our general map to decide which rides to visit at any given time.

Take a break in the middle of the day. Especially if you've got young tadpoles, we suggest taking a break in the afternoon and then coming back in the evening for dinner and fireworks.
