SkyDeck Chicago

Getting In: enter through Wacker between Adams St. and Jackson St. Head up the stairs and present your pass at the customer service kiosk during Skydeck's operating hours to receive the next available timed ticket for admission. Entry times are based on availability - we recommend arriving early Friday evening, Saturday morning or Sunday morning for the most flexible entry options.

Please note: All Skydeck Chicago visitors must go through a security check in order to be admitted to the Observatory. During peak hours, the security line can be lengthy, but it moves quickly. Occasionally, the 99th floor is used for observation instead of the 103 Skydeck Chicago when maintenance is required.

Insider tip: You will be able to skip the ticketing line but will experience a line for the elevator. To avoid crowds or elevator lines, visit SkyDeck Chicago early in the day.

Four-Hour Bike Rental by Bike and Roll Chicago
