



Disneyland® Park 2-Day Plan

Disneyland® Park is the first theme park Walt Disney created and remains heavy on the nostalgia — with classic rides such as Pirates of the Caribbean, Jungle Cruise and Mr. Toad’s Wild Ride. With so many attractions, we recommend planning to explore this park for at least two days and using FASTPASS, Disney’s ride wait system, and MaxPass, an optional paid add-on that allows you to make FASTPASS reservations from your smartphone.

We suggest arriving at least 30 minutes ahead of official opening, so that you are one of the first to enter the park. (Guests who are driving should arrive an hour early to park and access the tram or parking shuttles.) Guests enjoying Extra Magic Hours or Magic Morning benefits are allowed one-hour early entry on select days (usually Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday). We recommend visiting the highest priority rides in the morning when waits are lowest.

With the Disney FASTPASS service, guests get FASTPASSES at certain rides that allow them to skip the line and return at specified hour-long windows later in the day. After getting a FASTPASS, a guest has a waiting period before being able to collect the next FASTPASS (shows like World of Color and Fantasmic! are an exception).

MaxPass is a paid add-on that lets you book FASTPASSES through your smartphone. You can buy it (\$10 per person, per day) through the Disneyland Mobile App once you enter the park or when you get tickets. It includes PhotoPass downloads for the days you have it. MaxPass saves a lot of walking and allows you to make reservations for either park when Park Hopping. Plus, as soon as you redeem your FASTPASS at a ride, you can immediately reserve the next one.

There are several things to take into consideration that could affect your park plan:

- ★ FASTPASS availability
- ★ Ride closures
- ★ Extra Magic Hours/Magic Mornings
- ★ Parades, fireworks and nighttime show schedules/availability
- ★ Park hours/crowd levels
- ★ Weather
- ★ Your own personal interests and ages, heights and interests of children



Disneyland® Park Single Rider Attractions:

Single Rider lines are an excellent choice for those guests who don’t mind splitting up their party in exchange for a shorter wait time. Guests must meet height and age requirements to ride alone.

A note about *Star Wars: Rise of the Resistance*: During peak periods, guests must join a “Boarding Group,” or virtual queue, to ride. Capacity is very limited and fills quickly. You cannot join a Boarding Group until you enter the park. If you wish to ride, we recommend arriving at the park at least an hour before opening and being ready to join a Boarding Group as soon as you enter Disneyland Park by using the Disneyland app or at select locations. You will be able to join one Boarding Group per day.

If you get into a Boarding Group, we recommend you do not follow a park plan. Instead, use our maps to determine when to visit your desired attractions.

Disneyland® Park 2-Day Plan

We’ve created this two-day park plan so you can experience the most popular attractions with the lowest waits, prioritizing rides that should be visited in the first hour, and the first two and last two hours. Decide which plan day to start with based on whether the park is having early entry. Start Day 1 on a Sunday, Monday, Wednesday or Friday (when early entry is not happening). This two-day plan assumes you plan to arrive by official park opening. (If you do attend early entry, we recommend knocking a few Tomorrowland and Fantasyland attractions off the list first, then start using this plan when the rest of the park opens.)

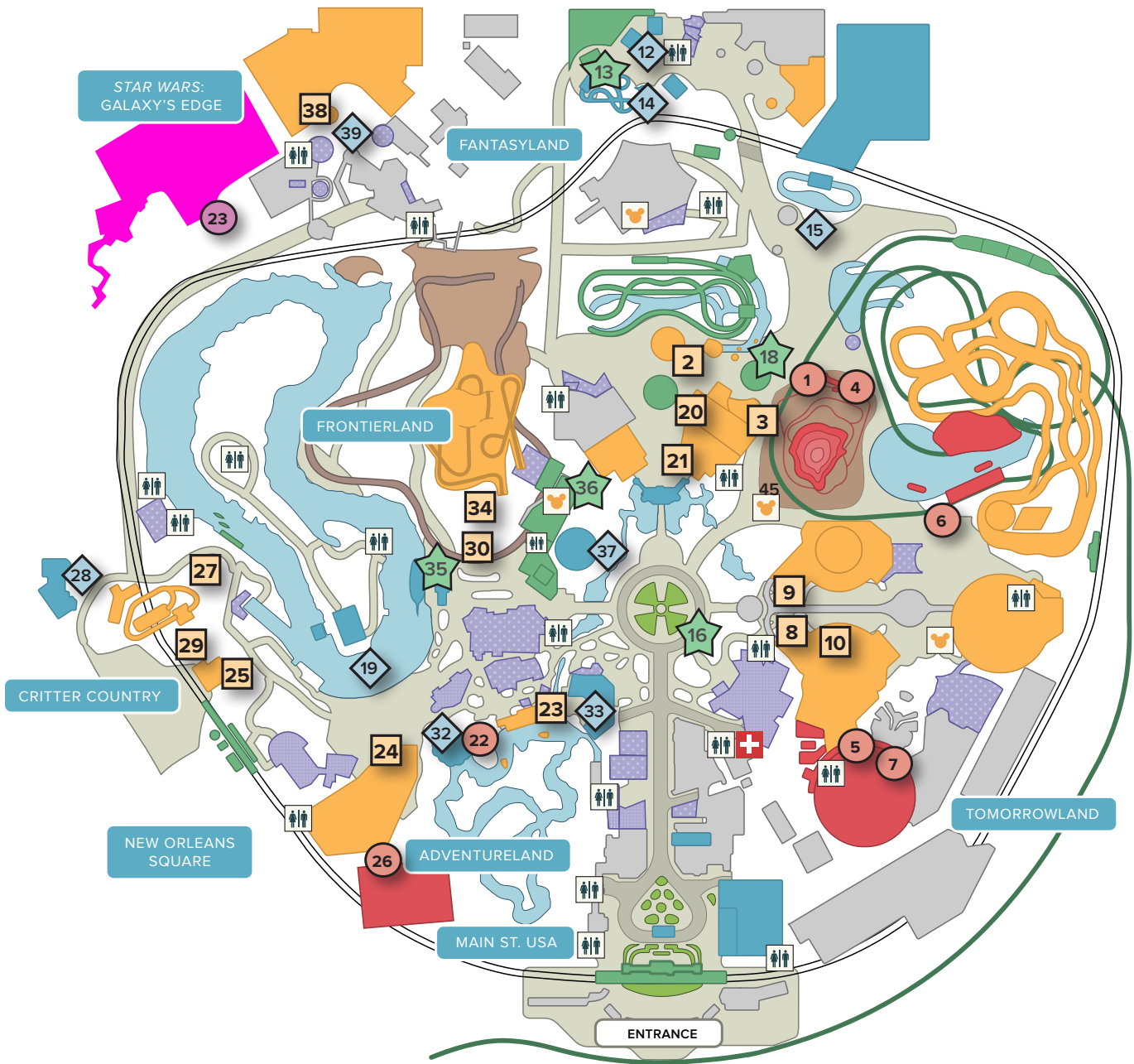

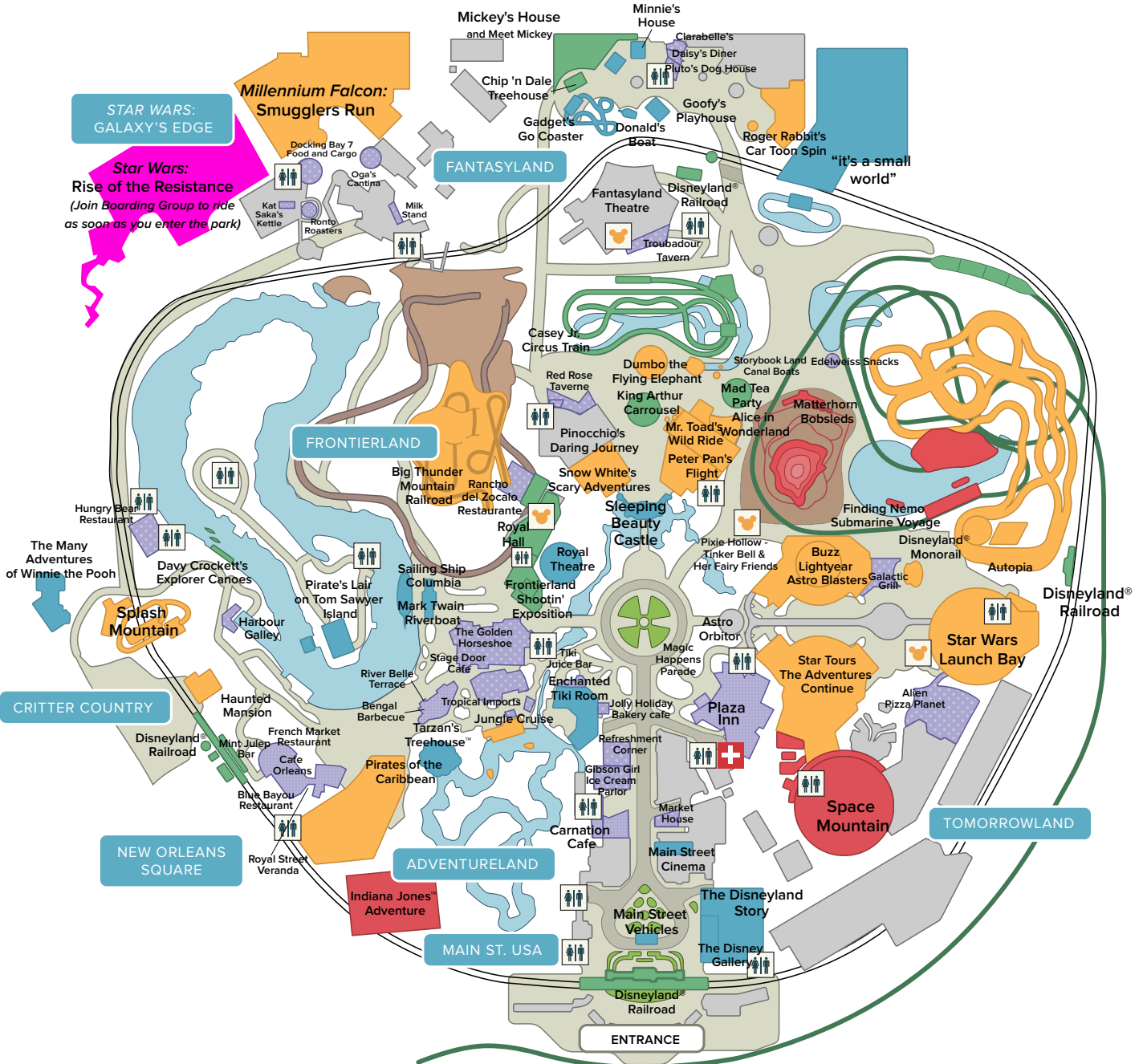

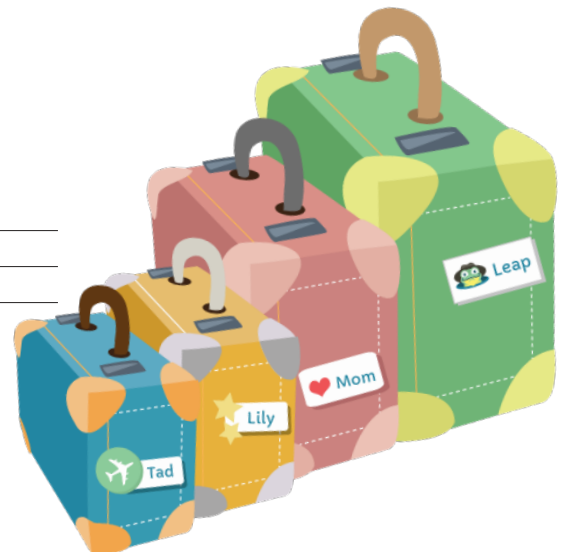
